### STRICTER LOCAL GUIDELINES DUE TO COVID-19

Information to students about new measures taken at Umeå University due to new local guidelines

# GENERAL

The following applies until 8 December, with possible extension

- Avoid visiting the university campuses unless absolutely necessary, and try to primarily carry out group work online.
- If you need to visit the University, it is important to maintain distance to those around you.
- If you must meet a group of people in person, attempt to stick to the same group throughout this period, both in your education and socially. The effect is best if the group does not exceed 7, according to the county medical officer.



# GENERAL

- Stay at home if you have symptoms of disease, also mild ones, such as coughing, a runny nose, soar throat, nausea and loss of taste or smell.
- When your symptoms have remained for 24 hours, you should also get tested for COVID-19.
- To not overload the system, however, it is important to only get tested if you have symptoms.
- While waiting for your test result, you must stay at home and may not meet others or visit the university.



# **TEACHING AND ASSESSMENT**

- **The department of Business Administration** have for the remainder of the autumn semester 2020 transitioned to online teaching where so possible.
- Hall exams are changed to online exams. Other forms of examinations are online if possible. You will be informed by your teacher.
- If you have the slightest symptoms of disease you may not partake in instruction or assessment that require being present in person.
- If you are carrying out an internship you must follow the guidelines and recommendations from your host organisation.



## **PREMISES AND EVENTS**

- University premises, including the University Library, will remain open during normal opening hours, but you are advised to avoid visiting the university unless it is necessary, and absolutely refrain if you have the slightest symptoms of disease.
- No events may take place in university premises. Serving alcohol is prohibited.
- Student's unions are urged to not organise events in other locations either, particularly those including alcohol.



### STUDY COUNSELLING AND STUDENT SERVICE OFFICE

#### For the department of Business Administration:

- Study counselling take place by e-mail/phone/Zoom.
- If needed, appointment by e-mail
- Student services office has temporarily new office hours: Monday – Thursday, 12:00–14:30
- In case of visit in person, please respect rules and keeping physical distance in the facilities
